THE PRESIDENCY (AWE INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL)

Currently the organization is headed by Co-chairs from 2 AWE Chapters. Kirsten Bruun of Danish Chapter and Reghu Rama Das of South Indian Chapter hold the position of Co-chairs. The International council also consists of 7 Vice presidents Viz.
